PRAIRIE HEIGHTS HIGH SCHOOL – ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

Guidelines for Nomination:

Nominee must...

1. Be a former athlete*, coach, or contributor of PHHS
2. Be nominated by a community member or current coaching staff member (per nomination form)

* Athletes must have graduated at least ten (10) years ago

Guidelines for Induction:

Inductee must...

1. Meet nomination criteria listed above
2. Be chosen through the Selection Committee, comprised of the Prairie Heights High School head coaches (Athletic Council)
3. Meet some of the criteria to be examined to determine the worthiness of induction includes (but is not limited to):
 - a. Any athlete who...
 - i. Distinguished herself/himself in the field of athletics while a student at PHHS above and beyond normal standards. This could include...
 1. Establishing individual school, conference, state/national records, or championships.
 2. Multiple year selection to All-Conference/All-Area, or All-State honors, or qualifying as an individual in State competition.
 3. Being recognized as an all-around athlete in high school in any sport while leading teams to conference championships, sectional championships, etc.
 - ii. Participated in college athletics and gained honors at this level or beyond.
 - b. Any coach who:
 - i. Distinguished herself/himself through her/his coaching career at PHHS above and beyond normal standards. This could include...
 1. Coaching athletes to individual school, conference, state, or national records
 2. Being recognized with All-Area or All-State honors
 3. Being recognized for leading teams to conference, sectional, regional, semi-state, or state championships, etc.
 - ii. Dedicated years of service beyond normal standards.
 - c. Any contributor who:
 - i. Distinguished herself/himself through years of service or going above and beyond normal standards of duty to PHHS athletics.

Number of Inductees:

The first class of inductees will not be greater than ten (10) members. Each class after that will be made up of no more than five (5) members. The number can be less than five (5). Inductions will be held every other year.
